SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Curfew and Liberty Buddy Exceptions to Policy

1. COMUSJAPAN memorandum, "Liberty Policy for All U.S. Military Forces Located and Operating in Japan," dated 26 November 2014, with an effective date of 9 December 2014, outlines the curfew procedures and liberty buddy program for military personnel in Japan. Pursuant to paragraphs 3c and 3d(4) of this Policy, authorized commanders may grant individual, event-by-event exceptions of limited duration to curfew and liberty buddy requirements. The Attachment to the Policy defines "authorized commanders" and states that "[i]n units where the commander is a General/Flag Officer (*e.g.*, in a headquarters staff), that commander may designate an O-6 or higher officer to serve as the "authorized commander."
2. I hereby designate Colonel Cory A. Mendenhall, USFJ J02, as my "authorized commander" for any Headquarters, USFJ curfew and liberty buddy exceptions to policy.
