

## WEASEL NOTAM 35 FW 20-03 Unit Level Instruction Approving Authority 12 Sept 22



**PURPOSE**: Establish the Unit Level Publication Approving Authority in support of the Operating Instruction (OI).

**COMMANDER'S INTENT**: To establish all Operating Instructions are to be approved by Squadron/Group Commander as the Approving Official for Unit/Group Level Publications.

**BACKGROUND:** In accordance with DAFMAN 90-161, Publishing Processes and Procedures, Paragraph 5.7. Delegation of Unit Level Publication approving authority is granted to squadron commanders/direct of staffs for new/revisions/cancellation/new of existing each squadron publications and forms. Formatting is to be completed in accordance with AFH 33-337, Tongue and Quill (Chapter 6: Step 4)

**IMPLEMENTATION:** Each Squadron/Group Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) is responsible for developing, formatting, and updating the Operating Instruction (OI). OPRs will consult the applicable HHQ and AF directives and/or guidance before drafting, revising, or rescinding a unit/group level publication to ensure compliance.

- 1. If a new OI is required or needs revision, contact the Misawa Publications and Forms Office (E-mail: Misawa Pubs Forms Mgmt-organization box). OPRs should post unit Operating Instructions (OIs) on unit SharePoint sites and shared drives.
- 2. Operating Instruction drafts will be provided by Misawa Base Publication Managers to aid OPRs with formatting their publication and/or operating instruction in accordance with DAFMAN 90-161, Publishing Processes and Procedures.
- 3. Each Unit/Group level instruction will be reviewed by the OPR biennially, within 6 months of Commander's Change of Command (CoC), etc. OPRs will also revise their responsible Operating Instruction anytime the OI is inadequate as written, or when administrative/organizational changes make the OI difficult to use.
- 4. Coordination will be conducted through eSSS or GEARS Program. The approving official's authentication/signature block is on the last page of the OI as a digital signature. There are to be no wet signatures on the OIs.
