Approved Wear of IWOL on Misawa Air Base

PURPOSE: To publicize the authorized wear of the Air Force Intermediate Weather Outer Layer (IWOL) top on Misawa Air Base.

COMMANDER'S INTENT: To establish wear instructions for the Air Force IWOL top outside of flying operations.

BACKGROUND: The Air Force IWOL top, in color sage green, has recently been procured by Misawa Air Base via PACAF and authorized as safe-to-fly. In efforts to reduce transition time and difficulties between pilot clothing and pilot equipment items, the IWOL top is approved for wear outside of flying on Misawa Air Base, adherent to the guidelines below.

IMPLEMENTATION: The guidelines set forth are established for wear of the Air Force IWOL top on Misawa Air Base.

The IWOL top is authorized for wear only in flight suits by individuals on flying status.

The IWOL top will be worn with name patches (with rank) on the left breast. If pilots do not have rank on their name patches, then they must have rank worn via Velcro (not sewn on) on the the right breast pocket instead of the MAJCOM patch. Unit patches are authorized for wear on the arms.
