

WEASEL NOTAM – 35FW-17-01 Approval of 35th Fighter Wing (FW) Personnel Travel to United States Pacific Command (USPACOM) Restricted Areas 13 Jul 20



PURPOSE: Define approval procedures for travel to USPACOM restricted areas.

COMMANDER'S INTENT: 35 FW/CC approves all travel to USPACOM restricted areas before and Individual Antiterrorism Travel Plan (IATP) is submitted to 5 AF for approval.

BACKGROUND: Per DODI-2000.16 Vol.1, AFI 10-245-PACAFSUP, Para -3.10.b.(4).(a) and 3.10.b.(4).(b) all travel requests to USPACOM restricted areas must be approved by the 35 FW/CC before an IATP is submitted to 5 AF for approval. Those who must travel to USPACOM travel restricted areas will register with the U.S. Embassy upon arrival in country and maintain heightened security precautions. The current list of USPACOM travel restricted areas are bolded in red on the "Country Threat Matrix" located at the following website below: http://www.pacom.mil/Resources/Travel-Requirements.

IMPLEMENTATION: Effective immediately, all 35 FW personnel will route a memorandum through their chain of command and the Wing Antiterrorism Program Manager to the 35 FW/CC explaining their justification for travel to USPACOM restricted locations. IATPs will not be submitted to 5 AF before the 35 FW/CC approves the travel.
