



WEASEL NOTAM – 35FW-18-06
Wild Weasel of the Month Program
13 Jul 20



PURPOSE: To recognize Airmen for superior performance.

COMMANDER'S INTENT: The 35 FW/CC directs the Wild Weasel of the Month (WWoM) program to recognize superior Airmen from across the 35th Fighter Wing (FW) that have not been otherwise recognized above the squadron/group level. This program incorporates the previous "My Story in Three Slides" as a part of the monthly All Units meeting.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. The Group assigned each month is based off the Wild Weasel of the Month Calendar located on the 35 FW SharePoint "Wild Weasel of the Month" page.
2. 35 FW/CCEA will notify the Group Exec when it is their Group's turn to nominate an Airman for WWoM NLT 28 days prior to the next All Units.
3. The Group Commander (or Deputy) will work with their respective squadron commanders to select one (1) Airman of any rank or AFSC as the WWoM using their own selection criteria.
4. NLT close of business on Wednesday of the week preceding the next All Units, Group Execs will send the following required information in an email to the 35 FW/Electronic Coordination org box:
 - a. Rank, Name, AFSC, Duty Title (ie., A1C Snuffy, John, 3F551, Postal Clerk)
 - b. One paragraph justification from Supervisor/Section Chief/Commander explaining the Airman's superior performance and impact on the 35 FW mission.
 - c. Content of the WWoM three slides.
5. The selected Airman and their supervisor will arrive NLT 15 minutes prior to All Units to meet with FW/CC and FW/CCC.
6. The supervisor/squadron representative will introduce the WWoM at the beginning of All Units, then transition the Airman to present his/her three slides (5-10 minutes maximum for three-slide presentation). FW/CC will then follow up with words.
