SUBJECT: Misawa Air Base Environmental Commitment Statement

1. Misawa Air Base is the only combined, joint service installation in the western Pacific vital to protect U.S. interests, deter adversaries, and project air combat power. Misawa Air Base is committed to executing 35 FW's mission while protecting our host-nation's unique natural and cultural resources through compliance with environmental laws and regulations. Every member of the Misawa Air Base community must adhere to the following:

- a. Implement environmental best management practices (BMPs) into the installation's standard operating procedures so that compliance is systematically incorporated into mission performance of Fly, Fight, and Win.
- b. Continuous unit improvement of the installation's environmental performance through routine self-assessment, pollution prevention decision making, and innovative solutions.
- c. Integrate Federal policies and directives, host-nation agreements, and Japan Environmental Governing Standards into 35 FW programs to ensure compliance with all applicable environmental laws and regulations.
- d. Communicate the installation's environmental compliance expectation to all personnel, contractors/vendors, and community members.
- e. Build trust with our host nation and community through excellence in all we do to protect national security and the environment.

2. All levels of leadership will provide maximum exposure to this commitment statement by disseminating through their respective unit and displaying the memorandum in conspicuous, common work spaces.
