

WEASEL NOTAM – 35FW-24-01 Morale Patch Wear & Approval 04 Mar 24



PURPOSE: Authorize wear of the colored Month of the Military Child Morale Patch

COMMANDER'S INTENT: The 35 FW Commander's intent is to allow military members assigned to Misawa Air Base the option to wear the Month of the Military Child morale patch throughout the month of April 2024. A morale patch is defined as a symbol locally developed, designed, and displayed.

BACKGROUND: IAW <u>DAFI 36-2903</u>, <u>Dress and Personal Appearance</u>, paragraph 5.2.6.1.2. and A6.3.10., Wing commanders may authorize the wear of morale patches on Fridays or during special events.

IMPLEMENTATION: Effective upon signature of this NOTAM, military members of Misawa Air Base are authorized to wear the Month of the Military Child morale patch on Fridays and during special Month of the Military Child events during the Month of April 2024 to enhance unit morale, esprit de corps, and foster a positive and cohesive unit environment for Operational Camouflage Pattern (OCP) and Flight Duty Uniforms (FDU).
