



WEASEL NOTAM – 35FW-18-06
Wild Weasel of the Week Program
7 November 2025



PURPOSE: To recognize Airmen for superior performance.

COMMANDER'S INTENT: The 35 FW/CC directs the Wild Weasel of the Week (WWoW) program to recognize superior Airmen from across the 35th Fighter Wing (35 FW) that have not been otherwise recognized above the squadron/group level. This program is a part of the weekly Wing Staff Meeting.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. The Group assigned each week is based off the Wild Weasel of the Week calendar located on the 35 FW-CAG SharePoint, under the 35 FW Wild Weasel Program folder, titled "35 FW Wild Weasel Program Activities CYXX".
2. 35 FW/CAG will send out emails and/or messages through the 35 FW CAG Info Hub Teams channel to all Group Execs notifying them when changes have been made to the Wild Weasel programs. It is the Group Execs responsibility to review the WWoW tracker to identify when their group is up to nominate an Airman for WWoW. The Wing Staff Meeting occurs every Monday in the Fighter Wing Conference Room (FWCR).
3. The Group Commander (or Deputy) will work with their respective squadron commanders to select one (1) Airman of any AFSC between the ranks of E1-E6 as the WWoW using their own selection criteria.
4. **NLT close of business on Tuesday of the week preceding the next Wing Staff Meeting**, Group Execs will upload the following required information to the 35 FW CAG Nomination SharePoint dropbox.
 - a. Filled out Wild Weasel of the Week card answering the *Living the Wild Weasel Legacy* and *Today's Mission, Tomorrow's Fight* questions.
 - b. Weasel Shadow smart card
5. WWoW slide must be uploaded to 35 FW Weekly Staff Meeting Teams slide template NLT Friday, 1400. Content of the WWoW slide is Rank, Name, AFSC, Duty Title and photos of member (photos of Airman on the job encouraged).
6. The selected Airman and their supervisor will arrive **NLT 15 minutes prior** to the Wing Staff Meeting to meet with the 35 FW/CAG.
7. The supervisor/squadron representative will briefly introduce the WWoW at the beginning of the Wing Staff Meeting, then transition the Airman to present his/her slide (3-5 minutes maximum for one-slide presentation). FW/CC will then follow up with additional narrative and recognition.
