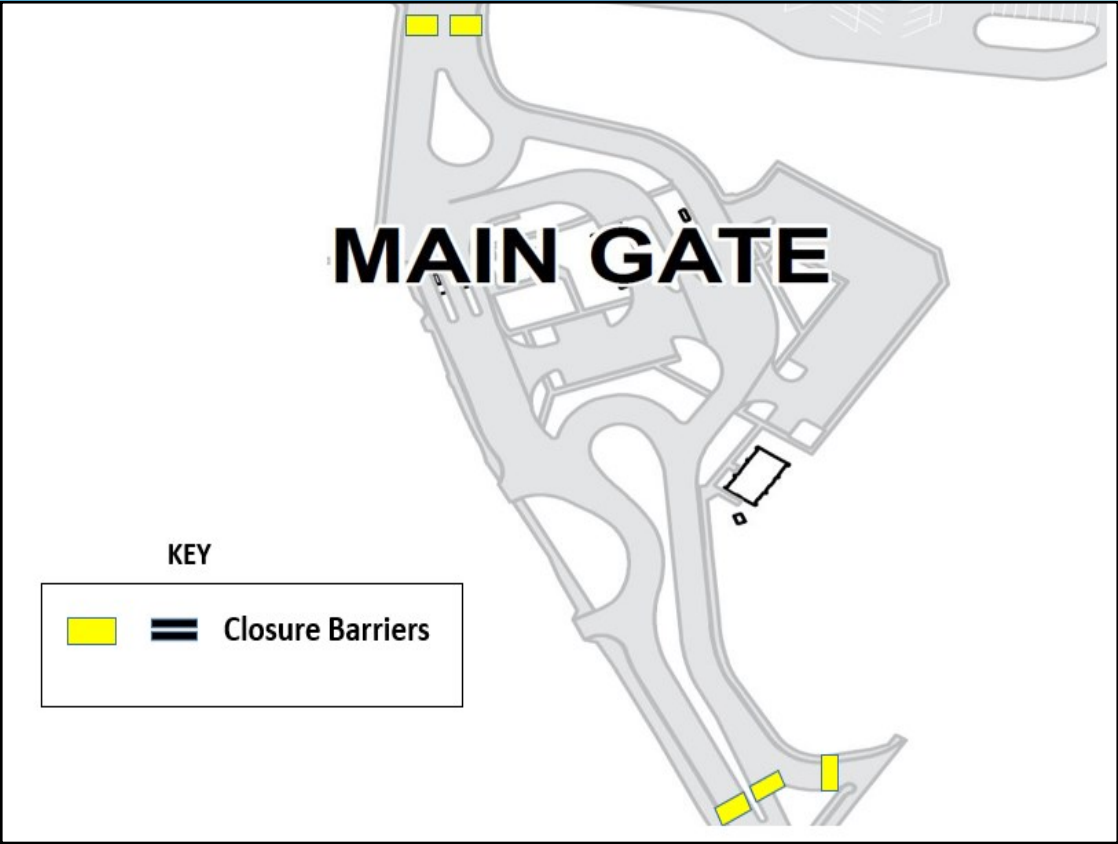

- The FW/CC may direct the installation Command Post to send out mass scenarios asking personnel to check their contact info (phone number & email) and update accordingly
